

No health care insurance?

Worried about how you are going to pay for your medical bills?

NDHC has a Financial Assistance Program for those who have no insurance and fall within the income guidelines.

Two simple requirements: You have no insurance coverage AND you fall within 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.

If you fall within the above two requirements, NDHC will reduce your charges to the same amount someone with insurance would generally be billed. Further reductions may be taken according to the Charity Care Sliding Scale as well. Charges billed to FAP-eligible patients will not exceed the “amount generally billed” to patient with insurance. This will be determined by discounting the gross charges by the Medicare- Critical Access Hospital interim rate.
